INTENDED AUDIENCE:

Primary care physicians (Internal Medicine, Family Practice, OB), physician assistants, nurses, and other care providers.

PURPOSE:

To help primary care providers improve their HIV prevention and testing skills to reduce transmission of HIV infection and promote early diagnosis.

PROGRAM OBJECTIVES:

Upon completion of this program, participants should be able to:

- Assess a patient's risk for HIV infection
- Identify ways patients/clients can reduce their risk
- Describe and demonstrate techniques for client-centered HIV prevention and test counseling.
