PURPOSE:

To help care providers improve their medication adherence assessment and counseling skills to maximize the clinical benefits of HIV antiretroviral therapy.

PROGRAM OBJECTIVES:

- Explain the importance of adherence to antiretroviral therapy.
- Identify factors that affect adherence to treatment regimens.
- Describe antiretroviral drugs and how they are used in HAART regimens.
- Explain client-centered counseling techniques.
- Describe the RIME/EARS model of Patient Adherence Counseling.
- Apply client-centered adherence counseling techniques to actual client cases.
